a. 2026-2027 FY Budget

Following a public hearing for the proposed budget that was held on June 9, 2026, the Board requested a few amendments. These proposed amendments included adjustments to salaries to include both a 3% merit as well as a 2.8% COLA, Public Works Director funding will be placed under Contracted Services, reduction to contingency as that is limited to 5%, public works position will be distributed differently with 50% being charged to the General Fund, 25% to Water and 25% to Sewer, the amount for payment to Kenly was able to be reduced as we had included an estimated 10% increase and funding was added to line item for water repair and maintenance.

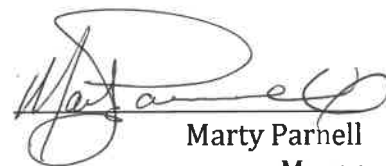

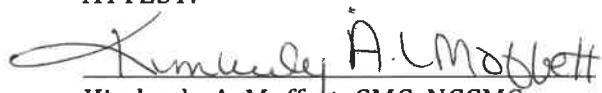
